

## COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

To reduce exposure to and the spread of covid-19 (coronavirus), CASA of Central Oregon is taking the following precautionary measures for **at least the next 2 weeks (until March 30)**. At that point, or if there is a change of status, we will reassess the situation.

1. CASA volunteers are to communicate with their program coordinators via phone and/or email rather than coming into the CASA office.
2. Do not visit your child in person. Please check in with child by phone, FaceTime, text or email as appropriate to the facts of your case.
3. Please work with your Program Coordinator to appear by phone in court, CRBs, etc. Please email the DHS caseworker and children's attorney and let them know that you will be appearing by phone.
4. If a CASA volunteer tests positive for the COVID-19, please notify the CASA office immediately.
5. CASA staff will be wiping down office surfaces such as door handles, counters, phones, and other frequently touched surfaces with disinfectant wipes regularly.
6. We encourage you to take the precautionary measures being recommended by health officials including frequent hand washing, not shaking hands, sneezing or coughing into a tissue and throwing it away, staying home if you think you might be ill, limiting travel, etc.

We appreciate all our CASA volunteers! We want all our volunteers, the children that you serve, and our staff to stay healthy. Please take the steps you think are necessary to take care of yourself. Stay in frequent contact with your program coordinator. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your program coordinator or call the office.
